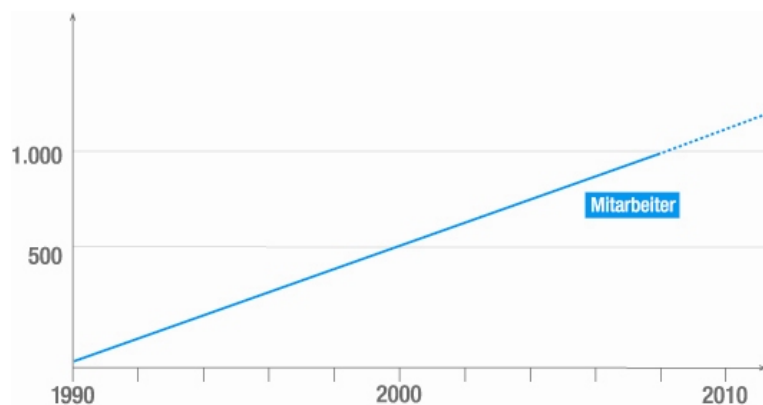
The Softwarepark Hagenberg places the emphasis on software and as one of the most innovative technology centres in Austria, it can network it into business, research and education and form a perfect synergy.
